Phillips' 'green' efforts recognized

Phillips Plastics Multi-Shot recently raised a Green Tier flag at its Eau Claire location, 1233 International Drive.

Green Tier is a state program that encourages a collaborative approach to the environment by partnering the Department of Natural Resources and Wisconsin businesses. Companies earning the recognition commit to reduce their environmental footprint by developing and implementing environmental management systems.

Energy-efficient upgrades at the Eau Claire location have led to an annual electrical power consumption reduction of 448,000 kilowatts. It is the fourth facility to earn the recognition for Phillips Plastics, which also employs an extensive recycling program.
