

Public Notice on a Letter of Intent to Participate in Tier 2 of Green Tier

Pursuant to Section 299.83, Wis. Stats., the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) hereby gives notice that DNR has received a letter of intent to participate in Tier 2 of the Green Tier program from Serigraph, Inc., 3801 E. Decorah Road, West Bend, WI 53095. Serigraph, Inc. is a screen and sheet fed lithographic printer, supplying plastic products for the appliance, computer, automotive and electronic industries

Under Green Tier, Serigraph, Inc. will continue and expand its superior environmental performance through waste minimization, minimize solvent usage, reduce electrical consumption, water use reductions, reduce VOC emissions and prairie restoration and maintenance. Serigraph has implemented an ISO 14001 functionally equivalent environmental management system (EMS).

As an incentive for continual delivery of superior environmental performance, Serigraph, Inc is requesting DNR issue a performance-based, cross media permit that would serve as its Air Pollution Control Operation Permit, and to simply recordkeeping and reporting requirements Serigraph, Inc. requests line-by-line variance from several applicable RACT rules (found in chs. NR 422, 423, and 424, Wis. Adm. Code).

Opportunity for interested persons to participate in negotiations

Interested persons may request authorization to participate in any negotiations concerning a Green Tier participation contract with Serigraph, Inc. To do so, send Jeffrey Voltz a request and a description of your interests in the issues raised by the letter of intent, within 30 days following the date of publication of this notice.

Opportunity for public to request a public meeting

Also within the 30-day comment period, individuals may request a public informational meeting concerning Serigraph's letter of intent by submitting a written request to the DNR contact. If DNR determines there is significant interest in Serigraph's letter of intent, DNR will hold a public informational meeting.

How DNR will make final decisions

DNR will determine whether Serigraph, Inc. has satisfied all of the eligibility requirements in sec. 299.83(5), Wis. Stats. If all eligibility requirements are met, negotiations between DNR and Serigraph, Inc. concerning a Tier 2 participation contract will begin 30 days after this notice is published and after a public meeting (if a public meeting is held), and will conclude within 12 months of beginning, unless DNR and the applicant agree to an extension.
