For example, many schools and hospitals may dispose of small quantities of a certain chemical, but these may be combined into a useful amount and reused elsewhere. After Veolia ES Technical Solutions recovers these materials they are often burned as an alternative fuel, used in wastewater treatment, or even redistributed to industry.

With the help of the Green Tier program and an Environmental Management System, Veolia ES Technical Solutions will pursue further recycling and treatment advancements.
