From Wausau: South on I-39/US Hwy 51; Exit at Plover; Left onto Plover Road; Left on Twin Towers Drive; Right on Water Way.

Fennimore Driving Directions:

From Madison: South on US Hwy 151; Exit (exit #47) onto Hwy 18 West towards Dodgeville; US Hwy 18 to Fennimore; Enter Southwest Wisconsin Technical College on Bronson Boulevard (building #400 is near the parking lot).

From Wausau: South on I-39/US Hwy 51; Exit onto US Hwy 12 (exit #142A) to Madison; West on Hwy 12 to Hwy 18 and 151; South on US Hwy 151; Exit (exit #47) onto Hwy 18 West towards Dodgeville; US Hwy 18 to Fennimore; Enter Southwest Wisconsin Technical College on Bronson Boulevard (building #400 is near the parking lot).
