

MOTORCYCLE OUTDOOR RECREATION

Authorization: s. 23.09 (25), Wis. Stats.

Budget: 2001-2002 Fiscal Year = \$100,000
2002-2003 Fiscal Year = \$100,000

Objective: Provide trails, intensive use areas, and related support facilities for off-road motorcycles.

Eligibility: Counties, cities, villages and towns.

Level of Assistance:

- Acquisition -- 100% of eligible costs
- Development -- 75% of eligible costs
- Maintenance -- 50% of eligible costs (if a trail is being maintained and it is a multi-use trail, cost-sharing is 100% of eligible costs)
- Insurance -- 100% up to \$7,000 per year

Priorities: Projects are reviewed for program eligibility as they are received.

Eligible Types of Projects: Acquisition, development, insurance, and maintenance of trails, intensive use areas, and related facilities.

Applications: Application forms are available from the contact listed below.

History: The motorcycle recreation program became a grants program to local units of government in 1978.
