Mary Williams regarding snowmobile supplemental and our funding process. It seems she has been contacted regarding the funding program.</p> <p>Larry is about 1/3 complete with audits. We have sent out the advance checks and letters as required prior to Sept. 15 and some checks are already being received. Prorate is currently at between 55 and 56%.</p> <p>A 13.101 request has been submitted and we are awaiting Joint Finance's next meeting and decisions.</p> <p>Received this supplemental after the August 1 deadline. Because this is statutory, we are unable to accept a variance request.</p> <p>Door County submitted a request for a written reason for denial of their bridge. The council discussed this project again. Motion by Bev Dittmar, second by Karen Carlson to approve the Door County bridge project at \$47,151. Trail Matters</p>	<p>Equipment and Labor Rates – update based on ORV Council decision</p> <p>Green County New Glarius (Trail 21) project</p> <p>Other ORV Council Decisions</p>	<p>The ORV Council approved 4 levels of processors within the ATV supplement. It shouldn't affect the Snowmobile rates though.</p> <p>A situation occurred when Sam Landes (Council member) visited the site with representatives from the club. It was then noted that the condition of the structure was such that it would not withstand snowmobile traffic this year. Sam was unable to attend the council meeting and asked that I forward the information to council members along with photographs of the structure. The entire structure the propose to replace is 30' with the club supplying the labor at no charge. The total cost is \$3,345.</p> <p>The only application we find for Green County (Allen Creek) was approved at \$19,970. Therefore, the only option available at this time is to repair under existing maintenance funds.</p> <p>The ORV Council approved the two projects that the Snowmobile Council approved at a 30/70% split, at 50%. Therefore, there is 20% that is unfunded at this time.</p>

			Motion by Larry Erickson, second by Tom Thornton to go ahead and approved the additional 20%. <u>Motion carried.</u>
