Section 23.09(1) and (2), Wis. Stats

The cooperative Day-old Chick Program (DOC) was established in 1936 to increase hunting opportunities for Wisconsin pheasant hunters. This form provides release locations for pheasants raised by cooperating conservation clubs. Cooperators and hunters are reminded of the following:

- Landowner notification of intent to hunt is required; however, a landowner cannot deny access for pheasant hunting. It is the cooperating clubs responsibility to make sure the landowner is aware of the DOC program regulations and that their land will be open to the public for pheasant hunting.
- Private and state-owned properties should be listed on this form.
- Local wildlife manager must be contacted at least 7 days prior to the release date.
- This form must be received by the local wildlife manager by **October 1**.
