

# Fall Turkey Hunter Questionnaire 2008

## **Abstract**

For the fall of 2008, the 46 Turkey Management Zones (TMZ) were combined into 7 TMZ's to allow hunters who receive permits a larger area to hunt and simplify turkey hunting. Again, fall turkey hunting with the aid of a dog(s) was allowed in nine counties in the west central part of the state. Seventy percent of all fall turkey hunters receiving a harvest permit hunted turkeys during the 2008 fall turkey season. The overall success rate for active hunters was 26.1%. Statewide, the average number of days spent hunting for fall turkeys was 5.6; hunting pressure was highest on weekends. The most commonly used method of hunting fall turkeys was ambushing from concealment. Despite the larger hunting areas, few hunters (8%) were interfered with during their fall hunt. Only 4% of active hunters "disliked" or "did not like at all" the new larger turkey zones. Overall satisfaction with the Wisconsin Wild Turkey Program remains high.

## **Methods**

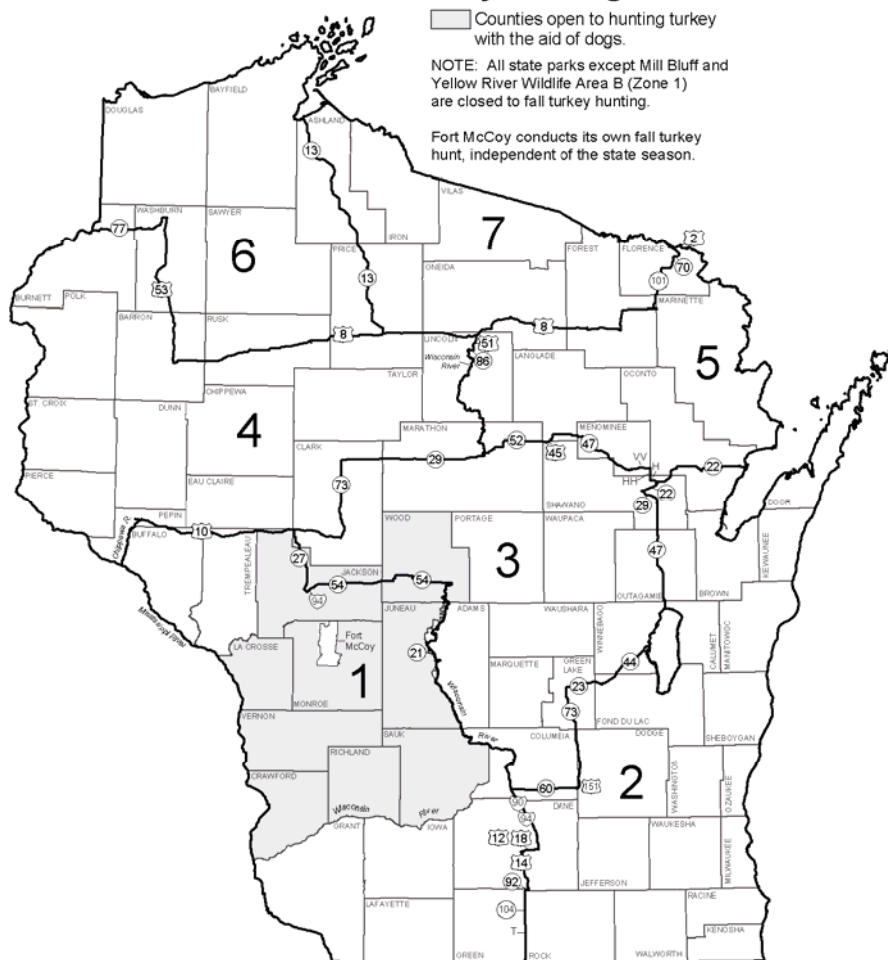


Figure 3. Continued.

A sample of fall turkey hunter names and addresses was drawn from the current fall turkey hunter permit file. A survey was mailed to approximately 6,000 fall turkey hunters after the completion of the fall turkey season. The questionnaire was mailed in proportion to the number of permits distributed in each zone. A portion of the 6,000 questionnaires,  $\approx$  1,800, had specific questions about hunting fall turkey with dogs. These questionnaires were mailed to permit holders where all or a large portion of the zone allowed the use of dogs for fall turkey hunting (Figure 1). All questionnaires asked each hunter specific questions about their fall turkey hunting experience (Figure 2 & 3). A second mailing was made to 3,000 of the non-respondents. Data from all returned questionnaires were entered into the DNR UNIX production server and summarized using the Statistical Analysis System (SAS).

## **Results**

A total of 3,015 hunter surveys were returned. After duplicates were removed, the resulting response rate was 48.8%; 49.1% for the "regular" questionnaire, and 47.8% for the "dog" questionnaire.

Approximately 51% of respondents have fewer than 5 years of fall turkey hunting experience; 29% have between 6 and 10 years of experience; 12% have between 11 and 15 years of hunting experience, and only 7% have 16 or more years of experience (Table 1, Question 1). These results are very similar to previous years. It would appear that many hunters are still just discovering fall turkey hunting; Wisconsin has had a fall turkey season for 20 years.

The start of the fall turkey season was moved up from the 1<sup>st</sup> of October to the beginning of the archery season in mid-September in 2007. This was done to give hunters more opportunity to hunt fall turkeys. This added 17 days to the start of the season in 2008, and was the longest fall turkey season ever at 69 days. Despite the longer season, the percent of hunters participating, 70.1%, changed little from last year, 69.6% (Table 1, Question 2). Hunters did spend slightly more time in the field in 2008, averaging 5.6 days of hunting, vs. 5.5 days in 2007. Hunting pressure was high on the weekends, with 54.9% of days in the field being a Saturday or Sunday (Table 1, Question 3).

Fall hunter success, based on turkey harvest registration data, was 14.0%. This is uncorrected for non-hunters and is probably a low estimate. Statewide, 26.1% of the respondents from the questionnaire killed a turkey this fall. Of those reporting, 21.4% with one tag killed one turkey; 34.9% with two tags killed one turkey, 22.9% killed two turkeys; for hunters with more than two tags 19.0% killed one turkey, 21.4% killed two turkeys, 16.7% killed 3 turkeys, 9.5% killed four turkeys, and 9.5%

killed five (Table 1, Question 4). This success rate is biased high because hunters who were successful may have been more likely to return the survey than hunters who were unsuccessful.

Successful hunters were asked how many hours it took to kill a turkey; the most frequent (35.0%) response was >10 hours, with a statewide mean of 11.7 hours (Table 1, Question 4a). Active hunters were asked if they hit any turkeys they were unable to retrieve: 4.3% were unable to find their bird; 75 hunters reported hitting one turkey, and 11 hunters reported hitting 2 or more turkeys (Table 1, Question 5).

Hunters were asked what weapon they used most, and what weapon they used to kill their turkey, seventy-two percent (72.3%) of respondents who hunted said that they used a gun to hunt fall turkeys, while 92.5% said that they used a gun to harvest a fall turkey (Table 1, Question 6).

The most commonly used method to hunt fall turkeys was ambushing from concealment (39.5%; Table 1, Question 7). Still hunting/stalking was the next most commonly used hunting method (25.0%). Shoot from the roost was the least utilized hunting method (0.6%). The mean number of turkeys seen by hunters while afield hunting was 24.1 (Table 1, Question 8), down from the 32 seen last year.

The percentage of survey respondents who reported the presence of other hunters interfering with their fall turkey hunting was 7.7%. Respondents reported archery deer hunters as the most common cause of interference. The second most common sources of interference were small game hunters (Table 1, Question 9).

Despite concerns that hunters in the “new” larger zones would interfere with each other, just over one-tenth (11.7%) responded to “other hunters kept me from hunting where I wanted to” with ‘definitely yes,’ or ‘somewhat.’ Similarly, 7.0% of respondents answered “there was too much competition from other hunters where I hunted” with ‘definitely yes,’ or ‘somewhat.’ Only 6.6% of the respondents indicated that other hunters interfered with their chance to bag a bird (Table 1, Question 10).

The number of hunters who rated their hunting experience as "Fairly High" or "Very High" was 34.7%. This was greater than the hunters who rated their hunt as "Fairly Low" or "Very Low", 21.0% (Table 1, Question 11).

Hunters were asked to rate several factors that influenced their perception of a “quality” fall turkey hunt. The most important factor leading to a “quality” turkey hunt was “seeing turkeys”. The next most important factor was “an opportunity to kill a turkey”. The least important factor was “weather” and “not seeing other hunters” (Table 1, Question 12).

Fifty-nine respondents reported knowing of 1 or more turkeys that were tagged but not registered. Sixty-six respondents reported knowing of 1 or more turkeys that were neither tagged nor registered. (Table 1, Question 13).

Most hunters (64.5%) would like to see the number of permits available in the zone they hunted remain unchanged, while 32.2% would like to see the number of permits increased. Only 3.3% would like to see permit number decrease (Table 1, Question 14). Most hunters (74.4%) felt the number of turkeys in the zone they hunted decreased or stayed the same from the year before (Table 1, Question 15).

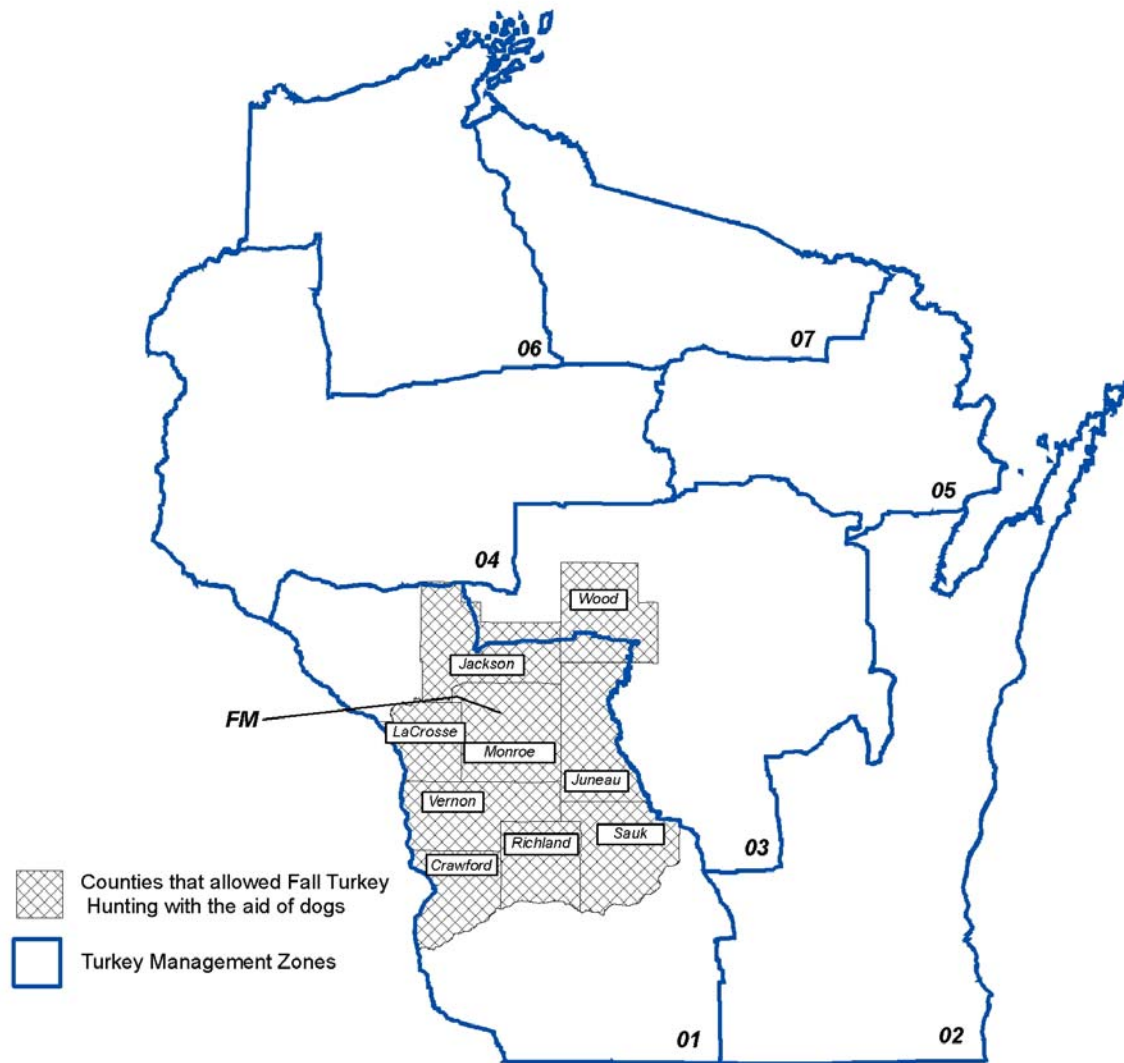
Respondents were asked to rate their overall satisfaction with the Wisconsin Wild Turkey Program. Over 77% responded as ‘very satisfied’ or ‘somewhat satisfied’ and 16.2% responded as ‘satisfied.’ Only 6% responded as ‘somewhat dissatisfied’ or ‘very dissatisfied’ (Table 1 Question 16).

With the new larger turkey zones hunters were asked if they changed where they hunted from prior years. Seventy-six percent of active hunters hunted in their traditional locations, while only 5% said that they hunted a location that was **not** available in the past (Table 1 Question 17). Ninety-six percent of active hunters were neutral or liked the change to the new larger turkey zones (Table 1 Question 18).

For the second fall, the hunting of fall turkey with the aid of dogs was allowed on a trial basis in 9 counties in the west central part of the state. It was legal to fall turkey hunt with the aid of dogs in the following counties: Crawford, Jackson, Juneau, La Crosse, Monroe, Richland, Sauk, Vernon, and Wood (Fig. 1).

Of the hunters who could of hunted fall turkeys with dogs, only 41% of hunters knew it was even legal to use dogs in their zone or parts of their zone (Table 2, Question 2). Eleven percent of the hunters said that they would have used dogs to hunt fall turkeys if they had known it was legal, while 31% said they would consider using dogs in the future.

Only two percent of survey respondents hunted fall turkeys with a dog(s) in the counties where it was legal. Dog hunters averaged 5.2 days afield and had an 8% success rate. The most commonly used method was to use the dog to break up the flock. Over 55% of the dog hunters felt that their hunting experience was "Much or Somewhat higher than fall turkey hunting without a dog". Results for dog hunters should be viewed with caution as sample sizes were very small and may not best represent fall dog turkey hunting. Results can be found in Table 2, Questions 18-25.
