

# Kinnickinnic State Park – 2011 Hunting

## Deer Hunting Seasons

The park allows deer hunting during the gun season November 19 - 27, 2011, and the late archery season November 19, 2011 - January 8, 2012. Archers are required to meet blaze orange requirements November 19 – 27, when the gun season is open. Kinnickinnic State Park is within Herd Control Unit 60M. Unlimited antlerless deer carcass tags are available for purchase at any license vendor for use in any Herd Control Unit. The park is not open for hunting in the early archery season, the muzzleloader season, or the October or December antlerless gun seasons.

## Hours

The park is open from 6 a.m. to 11 p.m. Hunters may enter the park no earlier than 1 hour before the opening of hunting hours. Gun deer and late bow hunting hours are ½ hour before sunrise to 20 minutes after sunset.

## Tree Stands

Portable tree stands may be used as long as they are removed from the property each day at the close of hunting hours. There should be no damage to the tree from the placement of a portable tree stand or by any other manner while climbing or hunting from a tree.

## Closed Areas

It is illegal to shoot a firearm within 100 yards of a building devoted to human occupancy while on lands you do not own. This includes the vault toilets in the park. It is also illegal to hunt or shoot from within 50 feet of a roadway's center or across a road.

## Trespass

The park map shows where the private property is located. Please be respectful and keep off of private property.

## Registration Stations

- Burkhardt Cenex, County Road A
- Prescott – Price Rite Liquors (Gun Season Only)
- River Falls – BP Amoco, Paulson Rd.

All harvested deer must be registered in the unit it was harvested or in an adjoining unit.

## Vehicles

All motor vehicles must be legally parked off of the roadways. Off-road use of motor vehicles, all-terrain vehicles (ATVs), and snowmobiles is prohibited.

## Park Admission Fees

Park admission stickers are required for all vehicles parked in or on roads adjacent to Kinnickinnic State Park year round. Admission fees are required at all state parks for hunting and nonhunting visitors. Please pay for fees at the park office or any self- registration box.

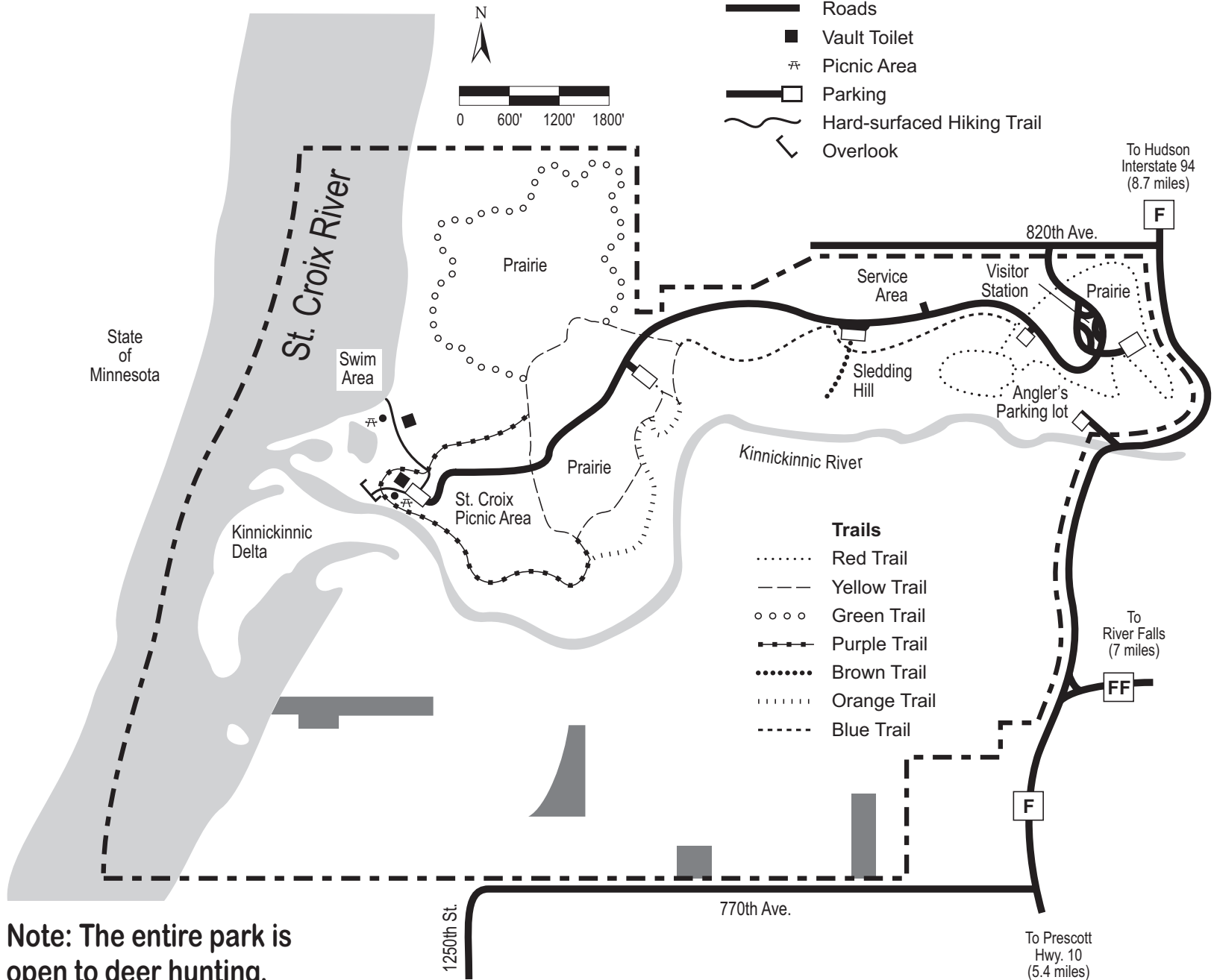
## Deer Hunting Map
