**SUMMARY:**

The Friends of Big Foot Beach State Park, Lake Geneva, Wisconsin raised \$9125.00 through various fundraisers and firewood concession sales. They have purchased a 2009 Polaris utility mule with those funds.

The new utility vehicle will replace a previous mule which ceased to operate in May of 2009 and was cost prohibitive to repair. The new mule will be used every day of the year by park staff to perform maintenance and various other daily park activities. Utility vehicles are critical to park operations as they are economical to operate and as such assist the park in saving gas and mileage expenses.

This donation will be used in a manner that ensures park visitors will have a high quality park experience for years to come when visiting Big Foot Beach State Park.

**RECOMMENDATION:** That the Board accept this generous donation.


