

# *Sustaining the Sheboygan River Cleanup Public Involvement Forum*

Maywood Environmental Park and the Sheboygan River Basin Partnership (SRBP) are sponsoring the final of a continuing five-part series of educational events on the cleanup of PCB-contaminated sediment in the Sheboygan River. The Goals of this Forum are to:

1. **Raise public awareness of the Superfund site and Area of Concern (AOC)**
2. **Provide a history and status of the Superfund project and AOC**
3. **Provide an update regarding PCB removal completed this summer in the upper river near Sheboygan Falls**
4. **Give concerned citizens, community interest groups, and local leaders an opportunity to ask questions and be heard**
5. **Provide everyone a chance to get involved in developing the steps necessary to clean up the remaining river**

The forum will include a panel discussion of concerned citizens, community/interest groups, and local leaders. The panel will discuss their hopes and needs for the Sheboygan River, which will play a vital role in establishing future river cleanup goals. Program attendees will also be given the opportunity to ask cleanup-related questions of the speakers and panel members.

As a followup to this forum, the SRBP will be forming a Citizen Advisory Committee to work on key elements of the Remedial Action Plan. We welcome all interested citizens and stakeholder groups to participate in the Advisory Committee.
