Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs) for Impaired Waters in Wisconsin

Public Notice

August 19, 2009

Section 303(d)(1) of the Clean Water Act (CWA), 33 U.S.C. §1313(d)(1)(C), and the implementing regulation of the US Environmental Protection Agency [EPA, 40 C.F.R. §130.7(c)(1)], require the establishment of Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs) for waters identified as impaired pursuant to §303(d)(1)(A) of the CWA. The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) has developed a draft TMDL for phosphorus and sediment for the identified §303(d)(1)(A) lake:

Little Lake Wissota, Chippewa County, Wisconsin

Upon review of public comment and revision, if necessary, the Department will submit this TMDL to the EPA for approval as final. Approval of this TMDL will result in an amendment to the Lower Chippewa River Basin Plan per s. NR121.083, Wis.Admin. Code.
