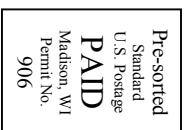

New Restrictions for CAFOs (operations with 1000 Animal Units or more)

Changes to DNR rule NR243

impacting CAFOs: Learn how they will impact your operation!

Here are a few potential ways. Join us to learn more.

- Additional restrictions on applying solid and liquid manure on frozen or snow-covered ground
- Additional restrictions when applying manure and process wastewater near lakes and streams
- Requirements for large CAFOs to have six-months worth of liquid manure storage
- Statewide phosphorus-based nutrient management requirements
- Adjustments to animal unit equivalency numbers used to calculate which operations are large enough to require a permit.
- Standard permit requirements for large CAFOs including mortality management, restrictions on chemical disposal in storage or containment facilities, stormwater controls and development of an emergency response plan
- Allowances for temporary manure stacking in winter
- Revised inspection, monitoring and reporting requirements

Expansion Workshops

Wisconsin livestock and poultry operators - are you thinking about expanding your operation to a size that will require a DNR water quality protection permit? If you anticipate having over 1000 animal units (AUs), you are required to attain a WPDES (Wisconsin Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) permit from the DNR. You are invited to attend one of three workshops that will be held at various locations throughout the state this summer. Visit our website (on front) and complete the AU calculation worksheet to determine how many animal units your operation has.

Representatives from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources will be on hand to speak about the permit process and the approvals that are required. Attendees will have a chance to speak one-on-one with agency representatives and receive an informational packet.

An operator who has gone through the WPDES permitting process will talk about the experience and the pitfalls to avoid when planning an expansion.

Current Permittee Workshops

These four workshops will include an overview of changes to DNR requirements that affect permit conditions for nutrient management planning, land application activities, monitoring and reporting, and submittal of plans for designed structures. Other topics to be covered include the following:

- Ways to avoid some common compliance problems.
- Identifying and reporting non-compliance with permit requirements
- DNR inspection and enforcement procedures.

Operation owners, managers, crop consultants, engineers and other persons who work with WPDES permit holders are encouraged to attend.
