Proposed Rulemaking to Revise Chapter NR 410

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) Air Management Program is holding an informational session for members of the Air Management Advisory Group (AMAG) on the proposed rulemaking to revise ch. NR 410, Wis. Adm. Code, under Board Order AM-10-23. The Air Management Program is considering increasing fees associated with reviewing construction permit applications and exemption determination requests. These fee adjustments are necessary to ensure that the construction permit program has adequate funding to perform its duties in accordance with requirements and deadlines mandated under the federal Clean Air Act and s. 285.61, Wis. Stats.

The intent of the informational meeting is to explain the need for this proposed rulemaking, review rule change options that DNR is considering, and gather feedback from stakeholders. Proposed rule text will not be presented during the informational meeting. Opportunity for the public to provide input on proposed rule language in Board Order AM-10-23 in accordance with s. 227.17, Wis. Stats., will be provided at a later date.
