# **Summary of Fishing Tournaments in Wisconsin in 2015**

### **Applications**

- 625 applications for fishing tournaments were received
  - 41 applications were either withdrawn or the tournament cancelled
  - 584 applications were approved and held
    - 369 catch-hold-release tournaments (63%)
    - 79 immediate release tournaments (14%)
    - 136 catch and keep tournaments (24%)
    - 118 ice fishing tournaments (20%)
    - 59 Great Lakes tournaments (10%)
    - 243 bass specific catch-hold-release tournaments (42%), which is the single most popular tournament type and target fish.





Figure 1. Wisconsin DNR Permitted Tournaments by County in 2015; the number of tournaments are shown in the corner of each county

#### Distribution

Tournaments took place in 66 counties throughout Wisconsin (Figure 1).

Top counties included Winnebago (39), Waukesha (28), Dane (27), LaCrosse (25), Oneida (24), Green Lake (22), Polk (22), and Barron (18).





#### **Notable Results**

- 23 more tournaments were held in 2015 than in 2014; an increase of 4% (Table 1)
- Prizes awarded were up more than \$1,000,000 in 2015 compared to 2014; an increase of 24% (Table 1)
- The number of bass registered increased from 2014 to 2015 by more than 5,500 fish (Table 2)
- The number of walleye registered were similar in 2014 and 2015; however, the percentage of walleye released decreased by 12% in 2015 (Table 2)
