Little Falls Dedication

The trout rearing project at Little Falls on the Thunder River was dedicated Saturday afternoon by the Stephenson Conservation Club which fostered the plan.

Nearly 150 guests were present at the Crivitz C. C. C. Camp where the dedication took place. Mr. Huigen of the Stephenson Conservation Association presided at the meeting. This project is the first of its kind in the state of Wisconsin comprising an area of forty acres purchased by the county board along the south branch of the Thunder River at Little Falls.

The work was completed by enrollees of Camp Crivitz under the supervision of the Technical Service. They built a road to the site, installed fifty-two tanks and made four rearing ponds. Conservationists throughout the county contributed to the fund to purchase the tanks. The project was then turned over to the state which is now operating it for Marinette County.

Principal speakers for the occasion were state assemblyman Louis W. Staudenmeier, who spoke of the benefits derived from such a project. He praised the CCC camp at Crivitz as being one of the most beautiful in this part of the country. Mr. E. O. Webster, State Superintendent of Fisheries, characterized the

Little Falls project as the finest trout rearing project in the state. Webster also prophesied that the project would be expanded in the next few years to furnish one can of trout for every mile of trout stream in the county.

This project is a monument to the diligent work of enrollees of Co. 3529, Camp Crivitz, Wisconsin, and will be a boom to the entire county by increasing the possibilities of our streams.

Hunting Season Nears
