Mixed Pulp<sup>1</sup> includes: 53% Red Maple, 26% Sugar Maple, 11% Yellow Birch and 10% Basswood, White Birch, Elm, and Ironwood combined. Mixed Saw<sup>2</sup> includes: 4 MBF Sugar Maple and 1 MBF each of Red Maple, Yellow Birch and Basswood. Species not listed will be charged the mixed pulp/saw price.

**The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. Contract ends June 30, 2025.**

**Special Sale Conditions:**

Equipment use will be allowed during very dry or frozen ground conditions. Equipment use in the Larch stand will be allowed from August 16 - May 31.

No harvest in selection cut area may occur from April 1- June 30 due to bark on residual trees being easily damaged during this time period.

Use of a continuous rotating saw head will not be allowed in larch overstory removal area due to density and distribution of existing regeneration.

Decking will be done along Price Creek Road and woods roads in sale area. All slash and ends will be removed from Price Creek Road and ditches concurrently with each truckload.

All slash within 100 feet of Highway M and Price Creek Road will be lopped and scattered to within 2 feet of the ground.

To make areas of sale operable during dry conditions, any new stub roads will most likely need pit run material. The state will provide the pit run material, but it will be the responsibility of the contractor for loading/hauling/leveling any pit run needed for decking on these new stub roads.

Culvert for proposed access road off Highway M will be installed by DNR staff.

Upon completion, all woods roads and access points shall be leveled, reditched if necessary and returned to the condition prior to the sale. Berms to be placed as indicated on map.

Avoid government survey monument illustrated on prospectus map.
