**The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. Contract ends June 30, 2026.**

**Special Sale Conditions:**

This sale is located in the Flambeau River Scenic Area. Equipment use will be restricted to very dry or frozen ground conditions from October 15<sup>th</sup> – March 31<sup>st</sup> in this area.

Decking will be done along woods roads within the sale area, except for road leading to open field due to ford crossing requirements. Decking will be allowed in the open field along north edge of the red pine plantation. The open field shall be free of all logging debris at the completion of the sale and any disturbed\_topsoil is to be leveled.

When decking in open field or along snowmobile trail, all slash and ends will be removed from field, trail and ditches concurrent with each truckload.

No decking will be permitted along Flambeau Rd. A back-in landing marked L on the sale map will be permitted to provide truck access to coppice area.

Do not fell trees or leave slash on or across fence along blue line. The contractor will be responsible for repairing any damage done to the fence.

To make areas of sale operable during dry conditions, existing trails and new stub roads will most likely need pit run material. The state will provide the pit run material, but it will be the responsibility of the contractor for loading/hauling/leveling any pit run needed for decking on these existing roads and new stub roads.

Sale will require a temporary in stream crossing permit. See location on map. Permit has been obtained by DNR, requirements therein to be followed by the contractor.

To comply with BMP's for invasive species, equipment should be cleaned of brush and soil prior to moving equipment on and off sale area.

No new landings shall be created without approval from sale administrator.

For sale inspection, call 715-332-5271 ext. 106 for the combination of the gate lock. **Please do not drive around gate.**
