Vilas County

The cutting area is approximately <u>159 acres</u>.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized. Whole tree utilization is NOT allowed.

Sale contains approximately 46 tons/acre or approximately 21 cords/acre.

Red Pine averages 16" DBH. White Pine averages 15" DBH. Norway Spruce averages 13" DBH.

Special Conditions:

- The snowmobile trail must be kept free of debris, snow covered in winter and always left in good condition for vehicle traffic. The trail must repaired to pre-harvest condition prior to each snow season. Slash within 50 feet of the snowmobile trail and Old K Rd. must be lopped and scattered to within two feet of the ground and pulled back into the sale area at least 10 feet. All slash within the <u>Red Pine Clearcut</u> area must be piled or windrowed for future site preparation.
- 2. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
- 3. All woods roads must be cleared of debris and leveled upon completion of sale.
- 4. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from the time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
- 5. Felling and skidding damage to residual trees must be avoided. Do not knock down or utilize any dead trees unless they pose a safety hazard.
- 6. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. Oneweek notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at this time can decide to remedy them before pulling off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.
