#### **Special Conditions:**

- 1. No harvesting, skidding or road construction from April 15th to July 15th due to the risk of oak wilt.
- 2. Landings for forest products are not permitted within the rustic road management area which extends 233 feet from the centerline of Hwy K.
- 3. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees.
- 4. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
- 5. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at this time can decide to remedy them before pulling off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.
