Section 26 – SWSE, SESE Section 35 – NE 1/4, SENW, NESW, NWSW, SE 1/4 Section 36 – NWNW, SWNW, GL 3, GL 4

15% of the total sale bid value will be required for performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 310 acres.

The contract period is <u>3</u> years ending June 30, 2026.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter will be cut and utilized. Whole Tree harvest is not allowed.

## TOTAL MINIMUM BID VALUE: \$118,762.00

1 Red Pine consists of 62% red pine, 38% white pine and trace amounts of jack pine and Scotch pine. Included is an estimated 158 MBF red pine and 117 MBF white pine sawlog material. Wt. Conv. = 2.250 tons/cord.

2 Balsam Fir consists of 86% balsam fir and 14% spruce. Wt. Conv. = 2.125 tons/cord.

3 Red Oak includes an estimated 11 MBF of sawlog material.

4 Mixed Hardwood consists of 54% white birch, 31% red maple and 15% hard maple. Included is an estimated 5 MBF of sawlog material. Wt. Conv. = 2.400 tons/cord.

Note: Total sale volume equates to 31.6 tons/ac. or 14.1 cords/ac.

#### Special Conditions:

- 1. No harvesting, skidding or road building April 15<sup>th</sup> to July 15<sup>th</sup> due to the risk of oak wilt with the exception of Zone A on timber sale map.
- 2. All slash within 50 feet of the tree line along County Highway N must be lopped and scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting.
- 3. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
- 4. Trees may not be felled into wetlands/swamp areas. Remove treetops and slash that fall into wetlands during harvest.
- 5. Do not operate equipment within 15 feet of any wetland or ephemeral pond unless the ground is firm or frozen.
- 6. Snowmobile trails must be kept free of debris and left in good condition for vehicle traffic at all times. Snowmobile trails must be repaired to pre-harvest condition.
- 7. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees.
