



Aspen Area (37 Acres) cut all trees >1" except oak, pine, and white birch.



Roadside Stand (18 Acres) cut merchantable aspen, white birch, balsam fir, and orange marked trees.



Main Sale Area (90 Acres) cut all trees marked with orange paint.



Oak Area (14 Acres) cut all merchantable aspen, oak, and maple. Do not cut any trees marked with green paint.



Optional Spruce Stand (3 Acres) cut all merchantable tamarack, black spruce, and fir. Do not cut any trees marked with green paint.

No harvesting will be allowed April 15th to July 15th due to oak wilt restrictions in zones designated A

#### No bid bond is required.

15% of the total sale bid value will be required for performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 162 acres.

The contract period is 3 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

Biomass (whole-tree) utilization is not allowed.

Timber sale volume (for all species) equates to approximately 42 tons/acre or approximately 18 cords/acre

Conversion factors: A 2.25 tons/ cord, MR 2.275 tons/ cord, FB 2.125 tons/ cord, OR 2.750 tons/ cord

#### **Special Conditions:**

- 1. Seasonal restriction: Units designated in the map key as "A" have an oak wilt restriction; restricting all equipment use during the period April 15 and July 15.
- 2. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees unless they are a safety hazard.
- 3. Slash within 50 feet of all roads, trails, private land, and waterbodies must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and be pulled back 10 feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting. No slash allowed across any blue line, or within any wetland or waterbody.
- 4. Do not cut any trees within 15 feet of ephemeral ponds. Access along the south boundary of the northern roadside strip may require timber matting or frozen ground conditions. Harvesting the spruce stand requires frozen ground.
- 5. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Do not damage residual trees
- 6. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved by the timber sale administrator.
- 7. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off site. During the "pull-off" inspection, provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at that time can decide to remedy them before pulling equipment off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen, documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.
- 8. All pine products cut between April 1- Sept. 1 must be removed from the sale area within 3 weeks from the time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
- 9. Snowmobile & hunter walking trails lie within the sale area and shall be posted/ maintained in acceptable conditions.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup>Red Pine weights consist of 60% red pine, 39% white pine and about 1% jack pine and includes an estimated 50 MBF or red pine logs and an estimated 20 MBF of white pine logs

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup>Balsam Fir weight consists of 64% Balsam Fir, 29% Tamarack and 7% Black Spruce

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup>OR weight includes an estimated 140 MBF of Red Oak Logs

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> MR weight consists of 87% red maple, 8% white birch, 5% black ash
