1 Red Pine consists of approximately 59% red pine and 41% white pine. Included is an estimated 135 MBF sawlog material. 2 Balsam Fir consists of approximately 50% balsam fir, 33% white spruce and 17% jack pine.

3 Mixed Hardwood consists of approximately 40% red oak, 40% aspen, 10% red maple and 10% white birch.

Total sale volume equates to approximately 24 tons/acre or 11 cords/acre.

Special Conditions:

- 1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Do not cut, knock down, or utilize any dead standing snags unless they pose a hazard to the contractor. Biomass harvesting is not allowed.
- 2. No tops or slash allowed across any blue line, red line, town road right-of-way or within any wetland. Slash within 50 feet of the highways/town roads must be lopped and scattered within 2 feet of the ground and pulled back into the sale area at least 10 feet from the edges of those areas.
- 3. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from the time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
- 4. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection, provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at that time can decide to remedy them before pulling equipment off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen, documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.
