Area 6 - Oneida Sandy Plains - Forest Production C6A - Stand 6 (137 Acres) is comprised of well stocked red pine small sawtimber that originated in 1932. This stand was last thinned in 2013. This stand will be selectively marked to favor and release the best quality pine. C7A - Stand 7 (52 Acres) is comprised of 54 year old well stocked aspen poletimber with associated white birch, red maple, balsam fir and oak poletimber. Some red and Scale: 4" = 1 Mile white pine sawtimber clumps are also scattered within the stand. The goal is to 1:15,840 maintain aspen as a strong component across the landscape. The stand will be regenerated using a coppice with standards forest management prescription. C7A - Stands 9 &16 (17 Acres) are comprised of of well stocked red pine small sawtimber. Stand ages range from 91 to 101 years old. These stands were thinned in the past with the most recent thinning taking place in 2013. These stands are well stocked at this time. The prescription for these stands will be an improvement thinning following the standard order of removal to reduce stocking levels and promote the growth and vigor of remaining crop trees. C7A - Stand 18 (37 Acres) is a 121 year old well stocked white pine sawtimber stand that is ready for an improvement thinning. This stand will be marked following the standard order of removal to reduce stocking levels and promote the growth and vigor of the remaining crop trees. There is a snowmobile trail that runs through a portion of the sale. The trail will be signed and kept snow covered if harvested during the winter. Biomass harvesting is not allowed.
