## Public informational hearing on Class I Air Quality Related Values and Threshold Effects Levels set for May 29 at Forest County Potawatomi Community

The Forest County Potawatomi Community will hold a voluntary informational hearing on Thursday, May 29, on the Community's Class I Air Quality Related Values (AQRVs) and Threshold Effects Levels (TELs). This process is being conducted as a courtesy to the public and is not required by local, state, federal or tribal law.

At the hearing the Community will provide an overview of its new AQRVs of visibility and vegetation and the TELs for those AQRVs, as well as for the AQRVs of water quality and aquatic systems recognized by the State of Wisconsin in 1999. After providing this overview, the Community will accept comments on the new AQRVs and TELs. The Community will also accept comments for up to 14 days after the hearing -- until June 12 -- and may respond to any substantive comments.

The informational hearing will be held from 1:00 to 2:30 p.m. on Thursday, May 29, 2014, at the Community's Executive Building, 5416 Everybody's Rd., Crandon, WI 54520.
