**Proposed Approval of the Wisconsin Lead (Pb) Infrastructure State Implementation Plan (SIP)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to ss. 285.11(5) and (6) and 285.23(2) and (4), Wis. Stats., and ch. NR 401, Wis. Adm. Code, the Department of Natural Resources will hold a public hearing on its proposed Wisconsin Lead (Pb) Infrastructure State Implementation Plan (SIP).

Background

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) revised the primary and secondary National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) for the air pollutant lead (Pb) on October 15, 2008. Pursuant to sections 110(a)(1) and 110(a)(2) of the Clean Air Act (CAA), states are required to submit a state implementation plan (SIP) to provide for the implementation, maintenance, and enforcement of a revised NAAQS within 3 years of promulgation of the revised standard. The State of Wisconsin's Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) has determined that the infrastructure SIP provisions are adequate to address the 2008 Lead (Pb) NAAQS as required under sections 110(a)(1) and 110(a)(2) of the CAA.
