Stats., the Department of Natural Resources, hereinafter the Department, will hold a public hearing to complete federal Clean Air Act requirements for the lead, ozone, nitrous oxide, and sulfur dioxide infrastructure state implementation plans (SIPs).

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the SIP developed under s. 285.11(6), Stats., will be revised. The Department will also be accepting comment at this hearing on the submittal to the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency of existing administrative rules and statutes addressing provisions of Section 128 of the Clean Air Act. as part of a revision to Wisconsin's SIP.

Action Subject to Comment


The Department is soliciting comment on addressing the CAA section 128 requirements.
