**Background**

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) revised the NAAQS for Particulate Matter 2.5 in 2012, effective on March 18, 2013 [78 *FR* 3086]. Pursuant to Section 110(a) of the Clean Air Act (CAA), states are required to submit a SIP to confirm that states retain the necessary authorities and resources to implement, maintain, and enforce a revised NAAQS (i.e., an infrastructure SIP). As such, the WDNR has developed a draft infrastructure SIP for the 2012 PM NAAQS.

**Action Subject to Comment**

The Department is soliciting comment on all elements regarding to the draft infrastructure SIP for the revised 2012 PM NAAQS.

**Agency Contact and Submitting Comment**

Comments on the proposed infrastructure SIP submittal should be received on or before June 19, 2015. Written comments may be submitted by U.S. mail, fax, or email and will have the same weight and effect as oral statements presented at the public hearing.
