Subject: Sampling of Property Located at 222 S. Marquette St., Madison

Dear :

During the course of investigating soil and groundwater contamination at the Madison Kipp Corporation (MKC) facility, soil vapor contamination has been detected on-site. The soil vapor contaminants detected include tetrachloroethylene, trichloroethylene and dichloroethylene. As you may be aware, the Department of Natural Resources is requiring the Madison Kipp Corporation (MKC) to evaluate the potential for soil vapor contamination on properties that share a property boundary with MKC, including your property located at 222 S. Marquette Street.

As the owner of record for this property, the Department is requesting your cooperation in allowing representatives of MKC access to your property to perform soil vapor sampling. This sampling will assist the Department in determining whether there is a potential human health exposure risk to you or others living in this home from contaminated soil vapors.

The Department will make every effort to inform you of any and all sampling results and what the next phase of work required at your property will be based upon the data collected.
