PECFA Claim Submittals

Chapter Comm 47, Wisconsin Administrative Code, has 13 different milestones at which a claim may be submitted for reimbursement; however, some of the milestones are no longer relevant, given the process changes PECFA has made. To achieve more balance between liability and reimbursement, and to ensure funds are available to claimants and consultants to continue work, PECFA is now offering the opportunity at all sites to submit a claim every 90 days if the costs incurred exceed \$5,000.

The maximum allowed for preparing a claim submittal on the current U&C Schedule (#7) is \$542.68 and is allowed in every 90-day claim submittal. Costs for scopes of work approved through the public bidding process are, with prior approval from the PECFA Claim Review Section, eligible to be submitted under this provision. The line-item cost for claim submittal provided in the winning bid would apply to the final claim upon completion of the work scope.

Note: Sites that have been approved for agent status are not affected by this process.
