**ER Review or
Proposed Review**
*NHI lookup and letter indicating
ER resources in the area to
avoid/minimize potential impacts
proposed project*
**Contact the ER Review
Program to submit a Review
Request or refer to the list of
[external Certified Reviewers](#)
who conduct Proposed Reviews**
*(If you are a Certified Reviewer, you
must have a NHI Data License to
access data for conducting
Proposed Reviews)*

NHI Data License
*On-going access to a NHI dataset
for multiple projects, tasks, or
purposes, and for a
large geographic area or a large
number of records*
Purpose—Project planning,
research, educational,
environmental, land mgmt, similar
authorized purpose
Format—GIS Shapefile, NHI
Portal, or both

**One-Time Data
Request**
*A snapshot—small number of
records or limited area*
Purpose—Research, educational,
environmental, land management
Format— MS Excel spreadsheet
and/or hardcopy of data
Training—Proper use outlined in
letter accompanying data
Cost—\$75/hr staff time
processing request
**Not intended for project planning
by consultants, utility companies,
or for Certified Reviewers.**

License
*For researchers, gov. agencies,
tribal gov., environmental group,
utilities, consultants (with
Certified Reviewers on staff), etc*
Format—GIS shapefile, NHI
Portal, or both
Training—NHI online training
\$250/trainee or Certified
Reviewer training
Cost—
*NHI Portal: Up to 4 counties or
species-blind data up to statewide
\$850/yr*
*GIS Shapefile: Up to 4 counties
\$1275/yr*
*NHI Portal, GIS Shapefile, both:
Any part of 5+ counties up to
statewide access \$1500/yr*

Sublicense
*For consultants to an entity that
holds their own license— to
conduct preliminary screening
and project planning (ex: utility
projects)*
Format—GIS shapefile provided
on a project-by-project basis by
the licensee
Training—NHI online training
\$250/trainee or Certified
Reviewer training
Cost—
1 sublicense: \$850/yr
2+ sublicenses: \$1500/yr
