Reporting “Watch Outs”

- Bolts should be converted to MBF and reported as log products.
- Mixed Products, by cord and by ton (18 and 18T) are to be used only if products are sold as mixed products.
- Report total values in the unit sale column as per unit values.
- For lump sum sales, report only per unit values for each species/product code sold. Values must be calculated and/or estimated and reported as per unit values. If values are reported incorrectly, then they will be returned for corrections.

New Reporting—Mixed Products, by cord and ton, for Aspen, Jack pine, Mixed hardwood, Basswood, and Yellow Birch and White Birch (A, PJ, MX, BA, BW and BY)

- At this time, we are beginning data collection for Mixed Products, by cord and ton (18 and 18T) for Aspen, Jack pine, Mixed hardwood, Basswood, and Yellow Birch and White Birch (A, PJ, MX, BA and BW and BY).
- We want to begin data collection at this time because our stumpage rate equation is a three year weighted average and we want to obtain three years’ worth of data for these new product and species code combinations.
- Thus, stumpage rates will not be established for Nov. 1, 2015 through Oct. 31, 2016 for this new combination of product and species codes.
- The Forest Tax Program will communicate when stumpage rates are established for these new product and species codes combinations and when these codes can be used on the Cutting Notice and Report of Wood Products from Forest Crop and Managed Forest Lands form (form 2450-032).
- **At this time, you cannot report Mixed Products, by cord and ton, for Aspen, Jack pine, Mixed hardwood, Basswood, and Yellow Birch and White Birch on the Cutting Notice and Report of Wood Products from Forest Crop and Managed Forest Lands (form 2450-032).**
