Sign up for Volunteer training

~ Volunteers receive training and handouts on Karner life cycle, wild blue lupine, nectar plants, Karner Blue Butterflies and other blue butterflies.

~ Volunteers will do population surveys of Karners and identify wildflowers for vegetation surveys at field sites (Sites are located in Central, Western, and Northwest Wisconsin.)

~ Volunteers select sites to locate and count Karners in open areas with lupine and wildflowers using road maps, aerial maps or personal knowledge of areas.

~ Volunteers will submit digital photos and report data in a timely manner to WDNR Karner Recovery program staff.
