Past and current environmental performance at W3855 Ebenezer Drive and all related land:

We have a Comprehensive Nutrient Management Plan in place, 2003

We follow a Nutrient Management Plan for our WPDES permit, WI -0061590-02-0 (awaiting approval for renewal)

We currently feed coffee chaff from Berres Bros. to our heifers.

We purchase whey permeate back from the cheese plant (Saputo) where we sell our milk and feed this to animals

We feed by-products from Ethanol plant (Valero) in Jefferson, bran syrup at this time

We feed distillers grain to our animals

We utilize milk chilling technology based off cold well water, which is then used to water our animals.

After July 1, 2012, Future plans for enhancing the environment:

Continue to utilize waste products from nearby companies that may be fed safely to animals

Explore ways to minimize electrical use, costs (fans, lights, motors, pumps, and more)

Continually evaluate use of grass waterways, tile lines, diversion terraces , minimum tillage and more to conserve soil

Continually look for ways to maximize output per acre of land and minimize inputs.

Utilize technologies like BST that increase efficiencies – more milk from same cow with a tad more feed.

Learn from other industries and another ag commodities how to enhance the environment, specific activities TBD.
