

File# FI 2779 – Sawyer County - 15.7 acres


The Department purchased this property in 2003 for \$20,800. This property was originally purchased to consolidate state ownership within the McDermott Brook Fishery Area. The portion being proposed is outside the project boundary and has federal funding.

The portion of the property inside the project boundary has approximately 3,188 feet of two-bank frontage on McDermott Brook.

The property has no road access, walk in access is provided through the Department’s property to the north, or County property to the south. There are some trails on the property to allow for angler access to the spring ponds on the north side of this parcel. There is minimal recreational use throughout the year as it is difficult to access, but it does provide connectivity to unique spring ponds and county forest land.

The Department has not made significant investments in infrastructure or habitat improvements

The Department recommends retaining this property.



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
