The Department acquired this property for \$500.00 in 1964, for trout habitat development and preservation along Hauer Creek, as well as public fishing and recreation opportunities.

This property has approximately 2,200 feet of two bank frontage on Hauer Creek/Hauer Springs, a class one trout stream.

This parcel includes an eight acre field that has been maintained as a seed production orchard by the Hayward State DNR Nursery. Department investments include mowing this field annually, instillation of a property identification sign in 2015. In the past this area received a considerable amount of local use. Fishing quality could be restored with a small amount of habitat work to reconnect the springs with the ponds.

The property is accessible through CTH F and is bordered by other Department owned lands being recommended to retain.

The Department recommends retaining this parcel.
