

# File G 1114– Jackson County 100.57 Acres

The Department purchased this parcel for \$3,750 in 1961. The parcel is a part of the Scattered Wildlife project and is located in the Town of Springfield in Jackson County.


An unnamed stream runs through the southwest portion of the parcel providing a total of approximately 1,975 feet of two bank frontage. Three minnow species were identified in the Natural Heritage Inventory (NHI) database for this property. These species include Redfin shiner, mud darter and pallid shiner.

The property contains several stands of merchantable timber including red pine, oak, aspen and white pine.

The Department has made investments in the property, including planting 31 acres into Red Pine.

The public can access the property through Hamilton Road and Rabbit Run Road. The property provides recreational opportunities such as hunting, hiking and bird watching.

The Department recommends that the Natural Resources Board retain this parcel.
