Eco-Driving Training to be Offered at Waukesha County Technical College

This October, thanks to a grant from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, Wisconsin Clean Cities and Waukesha County Technical College will be offering a new training course in Eco-Driving for Class 8 over-the-road trucks. This is an invaluable opportunity for fleets to reduce their fuel costs.

The course is intended to teach drivers ecologically and financially sound techniques like efficient route planning, vehicle maintenance checks, efficient refueling, and eco-driving skills.

The course consists of two hours of classroom learning, one hour simulator training, and two hours of on-the-road driving. Drivers that complete the course are also required to attend a two hour follow-up session.

The training is free, but attendees must be located in Southeastern Wisconsin. There are six spots open per class, and it is first come, first serve. So sign your fleet up today!
