### **Village of Palmyra seeks grant for acquisition of land**

#### ***Grant requested for Stewardship acquisition project in village of Palmyra***

FORT ATKINSON, Wis. – The Village of Palmyra has applied for a 50% matching grant from the Urban Greenspace sub-program of the [Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program](#) to assist with the purchase of 44 acres of land in the Village of Palmyra in Jefferson County. Village of Palmyra will provide match to the grant award.

The property is being acquired for a new park called the Southwest Neighborhood Special Purpose Park and will include bow hunting by permit, trapping by permit, hiking, cross-county skiing, snowshoeing, and nature appreciation.
