

Door County Land Trust seeks Stewardship Grant for acquisition of land on Washington Island

Washington Island, Wis. – The Door County Land Trust has applied for a 50 percent matching grant from the Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program to assist with the purchase of 42 acres of land on Washington Island in Door County. Door County Land Trust will provide match to the grant award.

The property will be left in its natural state and will be open to the public for low impact recreational activities including hunting, fishing, trapping, hiking, and cross-country skiing.

A Type III action is one that normally does not have the potential to cause significant environmental effects, normally does not significantly affect energy usage, and normally does not involve unresolved conflicts in the use of available resources.
