Minimum Acceptable Bid: \$43,159.40

Harvest Requirements:

Hardwood Thin Area (76 Acres): Harvest all Aspen, 3 stick or more Balsam Fir, and any trees marked with BLUE paint. In addition harvest all trees which are broken, uprooted or leaning at a greater than 20 degree angle from vertical. All slash must be kept less than 24" above ground level within 100' of travel ways, use areas, and waterways.

Red Pine Thin Area (71 Acres): Harvest all Aspen, 3 stick or more Balsam Fir, and any trees marked with BLUE paint. In addition, harvest all trees which are broken, uprooted or leaning at a greater than 20 degree angle from vertical. All slash must be kept less than 24" above ground level within 100' of travel ways, use areas, and waterways.

Clear Cut Area (30 Acres): Harvest all trees 2" in diameter and greater EXCEPT: White Pine, Red Oak, Yellow Birch, Hemlock, Cedar, Elm, Spruce, 2 stick or less Balsam Fir and any trees marked in orange paint. In addition, harvest all trees which are broken, uprooted or leaning at a greater than 20 degree angle from vertical.

Additional Requirements:

- Harvesting operation may occur during dry or frozen ground conditions
- All slash must be kept clear of travel ways at all times, and out of wetlands and riparian areas
- If harvested during winter, a minimum of 4" compacted snow shall be left on FR 174 (Snowmobile Trail)
- Known areas with weed infestation will be flagged by DNR and avoided during operations.
- All road maintenance and rehabilitation post-harvest is the purchaser's responsibility. A sample contract including road maintenance specifications can be obtained by request. Contact DNR Forester Jim Kujala at the Hayward DNR Service center (715)634-7426 for more information.
- Sale will be billed using mill ticket system
- No bid bond required, a performance bond of 15% of the total sale bid value will be required. 2 year contract period
- No Hauling on Camp Rd. on weekends (noon Friday through midnight Sunday) and holidays (Daylight hours on Memorial Day, 4th of July, and Labor Day)
- No slash is allowed within 10' of camp road or water bodies.
- Reserve all snags that do not pose a safety risk
- Equipment must be cleaned of dirt and debris before entering sale area
- No Decking on Town Roads without written permission of the Township


Good Neighbor Authority Sale Area Map



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 -  Red Pine Thin Area(71 Acres): Harvest all Aspen, 3 stick or more Balsam Fir, and any trees marked with BLUE paint. In addition, harvest all trees which are broken, uprooted or leaning at a greater than 20 degree angle from vertical.
 -  Clear Cut Area(30 Acres): Harvest all trees 2" in diameter and larger EXCEPT: White Pine, Red Oak, Yellow Birch, Hemlock, Cedar, Elm, Spruce, 2 stick or less Balsam Fir and any trees marked in orange paint. In addition, harvest all trees which are broken, uprooted or leaning at a greater than 20 degree angle from vertical.
