Minimum Acceptable Bid: \$15,905.00

Harvest Requirements:

Hardwood Thin Area (84 Acres): Harvest all Aspen, White Birch, 3 stick or more Balsam Fir, Ironwood and any trees marked with BLUE paint. In addition, harvest all trees which are broken, uprooted or leaning at a greater than 20 degree angle from vertical. All slash must be kept within 24" of ground level. All private boundary lines are identified by "Forest Boundary" signs.

Clear Cut Area (33 Acres): Harvest all trees 2" in diameter and larger EXCEPT: all pine, red oak, yellow birch, elm, cherry, cedar, hemlock and any trees marked with ORANGE paint. In addition, harvest any trees which are broken, uprooted or leaning at a greater than 20 degree angle regardless of species. All slash must be kept within 24" of ground level.

Additional Requirements:

- Harvesting operation may occur during dry or frozen ground conditions
- All slash must be kept clear of travel ways at all times, and out of wetlands and riparian areas
- If harvested during winter, a minimum of 4" compacted snow shall be left on any snowmobile trails
- Known areas with weed infestation will be flagged by DNR and avoided during operations.
- All road maintenance and rehabilitation post-harvest is the purchaser's responsibility. A sample contract including road maintenance specifications can be obtained by request. Contact DNR Forester Jim Kujala at the Hayward DNR Service center (715)634-7426 for more information.
- Sale will be billed using mill ticket system
- No bid bond required, a performance bond of 15% of the total sale bid value will be required. 2 year contract period
- No slash is allowed within 10' of public roads, use areas or water bodies.
- Reserve all snags that do not pose a safety hazard
- Equipment must be cleaned of dirt and debris prior to entering sale area.
- No hauling will be permitted on FR 1666.
