


Flambeau River State Forest Sale Locator Map


¹Mixed pulp includes 74% red maple, 17% sugar maple, 6% ash, 2% basswood and 1% of white birch, yellow birch, and cherry. The mixed pulp also includes 31 MBF red maple, 4 MBF sugar maple, 5 MBF ash and 2 MBF of basswood/yellow birch/white birch. ²If any larch is cut to widen road, it will be included with the spruce price. Other species not mentioned will be charged at the mixed pulp price.

The bid bond will be 15% of the total sale value. This will also be used as the performance bond. Contract length is approximately two years.


SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

1. Equipment use will be restricted to frozen ground conditions only due to high water table.
2. Pole length skidding will be allowed only in aspen areas. Landings will be limited to 100 ft. by 200 ft.
3. New road construction must be approved by Forester.
4. No slash will be left in ditches of Cty Rd W ROW or state forest access road. Slash that is within 100 feet of Cty. Rd. W will be lopped to within 2 feet of the ground by the contractor.
5. Caution: This tract borders numerous wetlands with scattered soft spots adjacent to them. Watch for small wetlands throughout the sale.
6. Timber mats or slash shall be utilized temporarily for accessing sale areas at wetland crossings as indicated on map. The timber mats or slash need to be removed promptly when completed in these areas. Placement and removal shall be the responsibility of the contractor.
7. Proposed roads and turnarounds on map may be modified with approval from Forester.
8. Contractor is required to close road at locations designated on the map by placing logging debris, per sale prospectus.
9. Do not operate equipment within 15 feet of the black spruce/tamarack swamps unless ground is firm or frozen.
10. The snowmobile trail crosses access road near Cty Rd W. Snowmobile trail shall not be blocked by snow or debris to ensure safe passage by snowmobilers.
11. There may be a survey marker near sale edge as indicated on map. Use caution when operating in this area.
12. "Leave Area" along Hwy W has orange marked trees. These orange marked trees are not part of the sale.
13. **All additional restrictions listed in prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.**


Tract 2-08 (FF#1 Sale)



Select Cut Area (167 acres) – Bounded by red paint lines. Harvest all orange marked trees. Sever all orange marked unmerchantable stems (canopy gaps). Do Not Cut trees marked with an orange X (these are leave trees). **Only cut marked aspen.**



Spruce Plantation Area (49 acres) – No paint separating the spruce plantations and select cut areas. Harvest all orange marked trees. **Only cut marked aspen.**



Aspen Regeneration Area (25 acres) – Bounded by yellow paint. Cut all trees greater than 2" except for: 1) hemlock, 2) white pine, 3) cedar, 4) tamarack, 5) oak, or 6) balsam with 1 stick or less.




Aspen Regeneration Area (3 acres) – Bounded by yellow paint. Cut all trees greater than 2" except for: 1) hemlock, 2) white pine, 3) cedar, 4) tamarack, or 5) oak.

****Note: Cut all balsam greater than 2"*****



Aspen Regeneration Area (4 acres) – Bounded by yellow paint. **Sever or shatter all musclewood and ironwood.** Cut all trees greater than 2" except for: 1) hemlock, 2) white pine, or 3) oak.


The bid bond will be 15% of the total sale value. This will also be used as the performance bond. Contract length is approximately two years.

SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

1. Equipment use will be restricted to **frozen ground conditions only** due to wet soil conditions.
2. No pole length skidding will be allowed in the select cut area, the spruce thinning area, or the tamarack strip cut area.
3. Existing woods roads will be used. New road construction will be necessary to access the sale area. The new road construction is limited to the proposed road layout shown on prospectus map. Modifications can be made with approval from Forester. Roads are not to exceed 15 ft. in width without permission from the Forester.
4. Landing size limited to approximately 100' x 200'. Decking is permitted along existing woods roads.
5. An active beaver dam exists along a portion of the existing access road to this sale (see prospectus map). Contractor must contact the Flambeau River State Forestry staff the **fall prior to cutting the sale**, so the removal of the beaver dam can be done.
6. **All additional restrictions listed in the prospectus and standard contract apply unless otherwise specified.**

Tract 17-08 (Lost Land Sale)

-  **Select Cut Area (61 acres)** – Bounded by red lines. Harvest all trees marked with orange paint. Sever all orange marked unmerchantable stems (canopy gaps). Leave, do not cut snags/cull trees marked with an orange X.
-  **Aspen/Balsam Fir Area (16 acres)** – Bounded by yellow paint. Cut all trees greater than 2" except for 1)hemlock, 2)white pine, 3)cherry and 4) oak.
-  **Tamarack Leave Area (44 acres)** – Bounded by red paint lines. No cutting in this area.
-  **Strip cuts within tamarack area.** There are 4 strips that run north/south and are designated with orange painted trees. Cut strips 2 chains (132 feet) wide, 1 chain on each side of the marked lines.
-  **Spruce Plantation Area (35 acres)**- Harvest all trees marked with orange paint. Leave, do not cut snags/cull trees marked with an orange X. No red line separating select cut area and spruce plantation area.

The bid bond will be 15% of the total sale value. This will also be used as the performance bond. Contract length is approximately two years.


SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

1. Equipment use restricted to frozen ground conditions due to wet soil conditions, except for the two red pine plantations marked with a "1". **No rutting allowed.** Although summer logging, during very dry conditions, is permitted in two of the red pine plantations, during wet periods the soils may become soft, and susceptible to rutting and road damage.
2. No pole skidding will be allowed within red pine thinning or select cut area.
3. Existing woods roads will be used. New road construction is optional, and is limited to proposed road layout shown on prospectus map. Due to topography and or drainage patterns new roads must be approved by State Forest staff. Gaining access through the private property is the responsibility of the contractor.
4. No additional access points will be permitted along Hwy W. Access points from Hwy. W are shown with an X. All loaded trucks shall exit pine plantations labeled as "1" on Nedli Road. Loaded trucks shall not exit via Hwy W access.(steep hill and poor visibility)
5. 3" of packed snow will be maintained on snowmobile trail, weather permitting. The trail will be kept free of debris. Public passage by car, atv, and snowmobile will be allowed on Nedli Road during sale operations.
6. No slash will be left in road ROW or within 33 feet of centerline. No slash will be left in the ditch lines of State Forest roads. Slash that is within 100 feet of Hwy W will be lopped and scattered to within 2 feet of the ground by the contractor. No slash or logging debris shall be left across the blue lines onto private land.
7. Road approaches to surfaced roads or other government public roads are the responsibility of the Contractor. Damage to these roads is the responsibility of the Contractor. Roads are not to exceed 15 ft. in width without permission from the Forester.
8. Decking will be permitted along existing woods road. Existing landings and existing woods road will be used. Decking will be located off of the snow/atv trail to avoid traffic. The decking of wood will not be allowed within 200 feet of a stream, trail, graded road or county highway. Landing size will not exceed 100' by 200'.
9. Contractor is required to place logging debris berms at designated map locations.
10. Avoid damage to government survey monuments illustrated on the map.
11. **All additional restrictions listed in prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.**


Tract 5-10 (2-Minute Drill Sale)



Select Cut Area (79 acres) – Bounded by red paint. Cut all trees marked with orange paint. Leave, do not cut snags/cull trees or trees marked with an orange X. Cut only marked aspen.



Aspen Area (33 acres)—Bounded by yellow paint. Cut all trees all trees greater than 2" except for: 1) hemlock, 2) white pine, 3) spruce with 2 sticks or less, 4) tamarack, 5) cedar, and 6) cherry.



Red Pine Area (55 acres)—Bounded by red paint. Cut all orange marked trees. Cut all hardwoods and aspen (Marked and unmarked). Plantations include both distinct and indistinct rows. Pine plantation 1 may be harvested during very dry conditions, pine plantation 2 will be frozen conditions only.



The bid bond will be 15% of the total sale value. This will also be used as the performance bond. Contract length is approximately two years.

SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

1. Equipment use will be restricted to frozen ground conditions due to wet soil conditions in select cut and aspen areas. Plantation Area A can be harvested during very dry conditions. Plantation B can be harvested during dry conditions during leaf-off conditions.
2. No pole length skidding will be allowed within the plantations or select cut area.
3. Existing woods roads will be used. Improvements will need to be made on several portions of the existing road system. New road construction must be approved by Forester. Decking will be permitted along woods roads.
4. Any decking on Payne Farm Road must have prior written approval from Draper Township.
5. No slash will be left in town road ROW. All slash that is within 100 feet of Payne Farm Road shall be lopped and scattered to within 2 feet of the ground. No slash will be left in the ditch lines of Payne Farm Road.
6. All orange marked trees along Payne Farm Road shall be harvested.
7. Contractor is responsible for debris berms on all woods roads accessing sale area from Payne Farm Road (except if road is gated). The berms shall be placed at the completion of the sale.
8. A temporary in-stream crossing (pole ford lined with geotextile fabric) shall be placed at stream crossing location. The ford shall be constructed as permit indicates. It is the responsibility of the contractor to remove the ford prior to spring run off.
9. A culvert will need to be placed by contractor along Payne Farm Road access to the northern most plantation area. It will be the responsibility of the contractor to remove the culvert and re-shape the ditch.
10. **All additional restrictions listed in prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.**

Select Cut Area (59 acres)- Bounded by red paint line. Harvest all orange marked trees within the designated boundaries. Sever all orange marked unmerchantable stems (canopy gaps). Leave, do not cut 1)snags 2) trees marked with an orange X. Cut only **marked** aspen and balsam fir.



Aspen Area A (52 acres)- Bounded by yellow paint line. Harvest all orange marked white pine and cut all trees greater than 2 inches except for: 1) hemlock, 2) white pine, 3) spruce with 2 sticks or less, 4) balsam fir with 2 sticks or less, 5) tamarack marked with an orange X, 6) red pine.



Aspen Area B (3 acres)- Bounded by yellow paint line. Harvest all orange marked trees. Cut all trees greater than 2 inches, except for: 1) hemlock, 2) white pine, 3) spruce, 4) balsam fir with 2 sticks or less.



Plantation Area A (13 acres)- Bounded by red paint line. Harvest all orange marked trees. Cut all 1) aspen, 2) white birch, 3) balsam fir 2 sticks or greater.




Plantation Area B (19 acres)- Bounded by red paint line. Harvest all trees marked with orange paint. Cut all 1) aspen and 2) balsam fir with 2 sticks or more.

The bid bond will be 15% of the total sale value. This will also be used as the performance bond. Contract length is approximately two years.


SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

1. This sale is located in the Flambeau River Scenic Area. **Area A** - Equipment use will be restricted to **frozen ground conditions only** due to the stream bed that runs through and parallels this area. **Area B** – Equipment use will be restricted to very dry or frozen ground conditions during **leaf-off conditions**.
2. No pole length skidding will be allowed.
3. No new access points will be permitted off of Flambeau Road. Only the woods roads along Flambeau Road marked with an “X” on the map will be used.
4. Only minimal road building will be allowed to re-open these woods roads due to sale being within the scenic area. No road building will be allowed past the proposed or existing turn-arounds. Proposed turn-arounds must be approved by Forester.
5. Access road to Area A has 2 existing rock fords. Take caution in not filling in these fords during road work.
6. Decking will be allowed in the opening north of the red pine plantation at the proposed turn-around location only as indicated on map. No road building beyond this point. If the topsoil is disturbed, it must be leveled at the completion of the sale. This opening is to be free of all logging debris at the completion of the sale.
7. The snowmobile trail will only be crossed in one location. 3” of packed snow will be maintained on snowmobile trail, weather permitting. The trail will be kept free of debris. Snowmobile trail shall not be blocked by snow or debris to ensure safe passage by snowmobilers.
8. Slash that is within 100 feet of snowmobile trail will be lopped and scattered to within 2 feet of the ground by the contractor.
9. Contractor is required to close road at the present berm location and at the location designated on the map by placing logging debris, per sale prospectus.
10. Watch for drainages and small wetlands throughout the sale. Timber mats may be required for crossing the drainage in the south west part of the sale. No dirt fill allowed. The mats must be removed immediately after use. Placement and removal shall be the responsibility of the contractor.
11. Do not fell trees onto or across fence. The contractor will be responsible for repairing any damage done to the fence.
12. **All additional restrictions listed in prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.**


