





Tract (14-15) CTTB Sale

- 
Select Cut Area (20 acres)- Bounded by red paint and Price Creek Road. Harvest all orange marked trees within the designated boundaries. Sever all orange marked nonmerchantable stems (canopy gaps). Harvest all merchantable ironwood and balsam fir.
- 
Red Maple/ Aspen Area (132 acres)- Bounded by yellow and blue paint, as well as Price Creek Road. Cut all trees greater than 2" except for: 1) hemlock, 2) white pine, 3) oak
- 
Red Maple Coppice Area (35 acres)- Bounded by yellow paint. Harvest all trees greater than 2" except for: 1) hemlock, 2) white pine, 3) yellow birch, 4) green marked trees, 5) nonmerchantable aspen. This area can NOT be cut until after herbicide treatment.
- 
Purple Area (2 acres)- Bounded by purple paint. Cut all trees greater than 1" except 1) purple X marked trees, 2) hemlock, 3) white pine, 4) oak.
- 
Tamarack Clear Cut (11 acres)- Bounded by green and blue paint. Reserve trees marked with green paint shall be left uncut and undamaged. Harvest remaining merchantable trees greater than 2" except: 1) green "X" marked trees, 2) white pine, 3) cedar, 4) hemlock
- 
Tamarack Strips (7 acres) - Cut all trees within 100 feet on both sides of orange marked center line. Cut all orange marked trees.
- 
Spruce Plantation Thinning (18 acres)- Bounded by red and blue paint. Harvest all trees marked with orange paint. Cut only marked aspen.

- Equipment use will be restricted to very dry or frozen ground conditions due to wet soil conditions.
- DNR will ensure access to timber sale. However, access across private property (if desired) is the responsibility of the contractor.
- Both existing and proposed access points from Price Creek Road are shown on the map. No additional access points will be permitted.
- Red Maple Coppice Area (35 acres): This area can NOT be cut until after herbicide treatment. Treatment will be conducted by the State during the summer of 2016.
- All additional restrictions listed in prospectus, map and contract apply unless specified otherwise.
