







- 2). **Coppice Regeneration Harvest (6 acres)**-Cut all stems greater than 2" DBH except for pine and hemlock.

Minimum Acceptable Bid for Entire Sale: \$7,330.00

Note: Bid bond not required. Winning bidders will have 6 weeks from the date of the bid opening to submit an acceptable performance bond to the department. The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. If the winning bidder fails to execute the contract and submit an acceptable performance bond, the bidder shall be required to forfeit to the department an amount equal to 10% of the total bid amount. Failure to forfeit the 10% penalty will result in the bidder being considered ineligible to bid on any state timber sales for a two-year period. Contract length will be two years.

General Sale Conditions

- Harvest areas are bounded by yellow paint line.
- Access will be off Price Lakes Rd. through northern road into Kimberly Clark Wildlife Area.
- Harvesting in forested wetlands will be conducted under frozen ground conditions.
- Snowmobile trail must be kept free of logging debris daily.
- Roads will be returned to as good or better condition following sale completion.
- Rutting policy will be enforced per contract.
