

Harvesting Prescription:

Aspen Regeneration Area: Harvest all trees 2" DBH and larger. **EXCEPT: swamp white oak, red oak, white pine, elm and hemlock.**

Northern Hardwood Selection Area: Harvest all orange paint marked trees. Harvest all aspen trees within the selection harvest area. Cut all ironwood 2" DBH and larger.

Utilize all cut trees that will make one or more 100" pulpwood stick to a 4" top D.I.B. Harvesting will only be permitted between December 1 and February 29, or during periods of frozen ground condition.

Integrated Resource Considerations:

Best access is through the David Rock property (contact Mr. Rock directly for information 262-878-2110). Any new road location and construction on State land is subject to review and approval by the Department of Natural Resources. Prior to the timber sale closeout procedure, all trails and roads used in the harvesting operation must be free of slash, logging debris, ruts and be level (pre-sale condition).
