




Tract (11-14) Gravey North Sale



Select Cut Area (95 acres) -Bounded by red paint line.. Harvest all orange marked trees within the designated boundaries. Sever all orange marked unmerchantable stems (canopy gaps). Leave, do not cut 1)snags 2)cull trees 3) trees marked with an orange X. Cut only marked aspen.



Aspen/Red Maple/Spruce Area (67 acres) – Bounded by yellow paint. Harvest all trees greater than 2 inches except for: 1) hemlock, 2) white pine, 3)oak, 4)cherry.

*Other species not mentioned will be charged at the mixed pulp or mixed saw price.

The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. Contract length is approximately two years.

SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

1. Equipment use will be restricted to very dry or frozen ground conditions due to wet soil conditions. A portion of the sale is located within the Flambeau River Scenic Management Area; within this area harvesting will be restricted to leaf-off.
2. No pole length skidding will be allowed in the select cut area.
3. Existing woods roads will be used and proposed roads may be built. Decking will be permitted along woods roads and forest roads. Any decking of wood along Carlson Road shall be located outside of ditch line such that it won't impede traffic.
4. Carlson Road and a portion of Hines Grade are ATV/snowmobile trail, 3" of packed snow will be maintained on snowmobile trail, weather permitting.
5. All logging debris shall be kept off of and out of the ditch lines of the hunter walking trail. All slash and ends will be removed from snowmobile trail and ditches concurrently with each truckload.
6. There are steep slopes and wet areas within this sale that will cause equipment limitations.
7. Use of continuous rotating saw head will not be allowed in the select cut area due to varying density and distribution of regeneration.
8. Avoid government survey monument illustrated on sale map.
9. Gates to be closed during non-work times.
10. New road construction is limited to proposed layout shown on map. Modifications can be made with the approval from Forester.
11. **Area within circle** must be harvested last and 1 foot of snow is required to harvest this area. Garlic mustard has been found near the section corner survey monument.
12. **No operations shall be conducted** on sale prior to the garlic mustard on the road being treated by the DNR forestry staff. Contractor needs to notify the DNR prior to any operations. The road will be graveled beyond gate to first intersection by DNR forestry staff.
13. If nearby sales are not completed prior to this sale starting, the snowmobile trail will be used for access for both sales. It will be the responsibility of the contractors to determine the logistics for hauling.
