




Tract 13-13 (Standing Woods Sale)



Select Cut Area (161 ac.) - Bounded by red and blue paint. Harvest all orange marked trees within the designated boundaries. Sever all orange marked unmerchantable stems (canopy gaps). Leave, do not cut: 1) snags, 2) cull trees, 3) trees marked with an orange X. Cut only **marked** aspen.



Red Maple Coppice Area (7 ac.) - Bounded by yellow paint. Cut all trees greater than 2 inches **except for:** 1) hemlock, 2) white pine, 3) oak, 4) trees marked with an orange X.



Red Pine Area (33 ac.) - Bounded by red paint. Harvest all: 1) orange marked trees, 2) merchantable aspen, and 3) merchantable elm.




These areas may be cut during very dry ground conditions (Approx. 85 acres). Access to these areas will need to be made off of Big Block Road.

Y - Yellow paint faces red maple coppice area
 R/Y - Red paint faces select cut area/Yellow paint faces red maple coppice area
 Blue - Blue paint between select cut area and private land

UB - Upland Brush
 SB - Black Spruce
 LBA - Lowland Brush - Alder

¹Mixed pulp includes approx. 45% of sugar maple, 32% of red maple, 13% of ash, 7% yellow birch, 2% elm and 1% white birch. ²Mixed saw includes white birch and yellow birch. Species not listed will be charged the mixed pulp price or mixed saw price.

The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. Contract length is approximately two years.

SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

1. Equipment use will be restricted to very dry or frozen conditions. No cutting can be done during the months of April, May and June.
2. No pole length skidding will be allowed in the select cut area or in the red pine thinning.
3. Existing woods roads will be used. Some road improvements will be needed. Location of new roads and turn arounds must be approved by Forester.
4. Decking will be done along woods roads within the sale area. No decking will be allowed on ATV/Snowmobile trail. Avoid decking on hunter walking trail if possible. No decking allowed in ROW of gravel road. If decking is done on hunter walking trail or gravel road, all slash and ends will be removed from the road and ditches concurrently with each truckload.
5. Slash that is within 100 feet of ATV/Snowmobile trail will be lopped and scattered to within 2 feet of the ground by the contractor. No slash or logging debris will be left across the blue line onto private land. No slash or logging debris will be left on or in the ditches of the main gravel road.
6. Damage done to the main gravel road is the responsibility of the contractor. Main gravel road needs to be left in the same condition as found or better.
7. Big Block Road will need to be used if accessing the west area of sale during very dry conditions.
8. Avoid government survey monuments illustrated on prospectus map.
9. Gate located near Cty Rd M needs to remain closed during non-work hours.
10. All pine cut or piled between May 1st and August 1st shall be removed within 30 days.
11. Use of a continuous rotating saw head will not be allowed in the select cut area due to varying density and distribution of regeneration.
12. **All additional restrictions listed in prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.**
