




(Tract 14-14) Tamarack Tract




Red Maple/Aspen Area (71 acres)- Bounded by yellow paint. Cut all trees greater than 2 inches **except for:** 1)hemlock, 2)white pine, 3)oak, 4)cherry, 5)spruce with 2 sticks or less, 6)balsam fir with 2 sticks or less.



Tamarack Strips (16 acres)- Designated by orange marked center line. Cut all trees greater than 2 inches within 75 feet of both sides of the center line **except for:** 1)white pine, 2)hemlock, 3)cedar. Cut all orange marked trees. (Strips should be 150 feet wide from edge to edge.) *Total stand is 49 acres. Area to be cut is 16 acres.*

¹Mixed pulp is approximately 59% Red Maple, 24% Ash, 10% Yellow Birch, and 7% Elm, Ironwood, Hard Maple, and White Birch. The mixed pulp volume contains 39 MBF red maple, 41 MBF ash, and 3 MBF yellow birch.

²Spruce volume includes approximately 43% white spruce, 37% black spruce and 20% balsam fir.

³Tamarack volume includes about 4 MBF Tamarack sawlogs.

All other species not mentioned will be charged at the mixed pulp price.

The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. Contract length is approximately two years.

SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

1. Equipment use will be restricted to **frozen ground conditions only** due to wet soil conditions and wet road access.
2. Existing woods roads will be used. Road work will be needed to improve existing roads. Additional road work for proposed road is optional but must be approved by Forester. Roads are not to exceed 15 ft.
3. Decking is permitted along existing woods roads.
4. Access into the sale is limited to the current access points from Hwy M.
5. Access to tamarack strips shall be from west road.
6. If nearby sales are not completed prior to this sale starting, the hunter walking trail will be used for access for both sales. It will be the responsibility of the contractors to determine the logistics for hauling.
7. Contractor is required to close road at the locations designated on the map by placing logging debris berm, per sale prospectus.
8. **All additional restrictions listed in the prospectus and standard contract apply unless otherwise specified.**
