





Tract (17-14) Camp 41 Sale



Select Cut Area (263 acres)- Bounded by red paint, Camp 41 campsite access road, and Hines Grade. Harvest all orange marked trees within the designated boundaries. Sever all orange marked unmerchantable stems (canopy gaps). Leave, do not cut 1) snags, 2) cull trees, 3) trees marked with an orange X. Cut only marked aspen.



Aspen Area (42 acres)- Bounded by yellow paint, Camp 41 campsite access road, and Hines Grade. Cut all trees greater than 2 inches except for: 1) hemlock, 2) white pine, 3) cedar, 4) cherry, or 5) oak.

¹Mixed pulp includes 34% hard maple, 44% red maple, 12% ash, 8% yellow birch, and 2% elm, white birch, black cherry, and ironwood combined. 5 MBF of Elm is also included with the mixed pulp volume.

²Mixed Hardwoods includes 12 MBF basswood, 2 MBF yellow birch, and 3 MBF white birch.

Other species not mentioned will be charged at the mixed pulp or mixed saw price accordingly.

The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. Contract length is approximately two years.

SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

1. Equipment use will be restricted to very dry or frozen ground conditions. Portions of this sale will need to be frozen to operate harvesting equipment. Portions of this sale are located within the Flambeau River Scenic Management Area operations within this area shall be conducted October 15-April 1st.
2. No pole length skidding will be allowed within the select cut areas.
3. Road building will be limited to proposed road. Existing woods roads will be used and they need improvement.
4. No decking will be permitted within 400 feet of the river.
5. Slash that is within 100 feet of the Flambeau River, Camp 41 road, Hines Grade, or Camp 41 campsite shall be lopped and scattered to within 2 feet of the ground.
6. Trees within 100feet of campsite and the Flambeau River have been marked on one side (facing away from the river).
7. No new access points will be permitted.
8. All wood within 400 feet of Flambeau River shall be removed prior to April 1st of each year of contract.
9. Hines Grade is a snowmobile trail. 3" of packed snow will be maintained on snowmobile trail, weather permitting. The trail and ditches will be kept free of debris.
10. Drainage area as indicated on map will need timber mats, poles, or a culvert to be crossed.
11. All logging debris shall be kept off of and out of the ditch lines of Camp 41 Road and Hines Grade.
12. Avoid government survey monuments illustrated on map.
13. Use of continuous rotating saw head will not be allowed within the select cut area due to varying density and distribution of regeneration.
14. **All additional restrictions listed in prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.**
